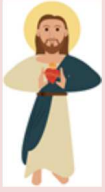

The children told the Easter story beautifully and it was wonderful to welcome so many of our families to school to enjoy their hard work.

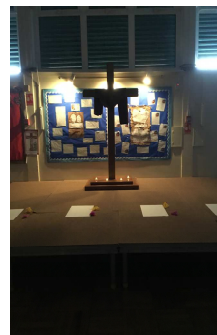
Chaplains
