



Sacred Heart RC Primary School Remote Home Learning Plan

At Sacred Heart RC, we understand the need to continually deliver high quality education, including during periods of remote working – whether for an individual pupil or many. We recognise the importance of maintaining high expectations in all areas of school life and ensuring that all pupils have access to the learning resources and support they need to succeed.

Parental Responsibility

Parents should ensure that their child is available to learn remotely during the hours of the school day, and that the school work set is completed on time and to the best of their child's ability.

Remote Learning Platforms – Microsoft Teams

All pupils have a Microsoft Teams Login and Password and this is the main platform for remote learning. Teacher will set work with the pupils' workbooks for them to access from home. These electronic workbooks can only be viewed by the class teacher who can then respond to pupils' work.

Other Remote Learning Platforms

Through Microsoft Teams, your child's class teacher might direct them to another platform to support their learning. As these are used in school, most children are familiar with how to access them.

Work Packs

Work packs may also be sent home to support on-line learning or for those pupils without access to the necessary technology.

Attendance

As long as children are well, it is expected that they complete their daily home learning tasks. If your child is unwell and therefore unable to take part in home learning lessons, you should inform school no later than 8.55am each day. Failure to complete tasks or to inform school of the reason could result in a non-attendance mark in the register.

Daily Lessons

If for any reason, children are unable to login in at a specific time to attend a lesson or complete a task set by the teacher, the work should be completed by the following day.

E-Safety and Welfare of Pupils

Please note: It remains our school policy that children should always access the internet with the supervision of a responsible adult. Please keep e-safety in mind when accessing on-line platforms together. Whilst working on Teams, children must be appropriately dressed and supervised by an adult in the same room.

Communication

Dojo will be used as the main method of communication between teacher and parent / carer regarding home learning. All Teams calls and communication via Teams is recorded for monitoring and safeguarding purposes
