Well done everyone.

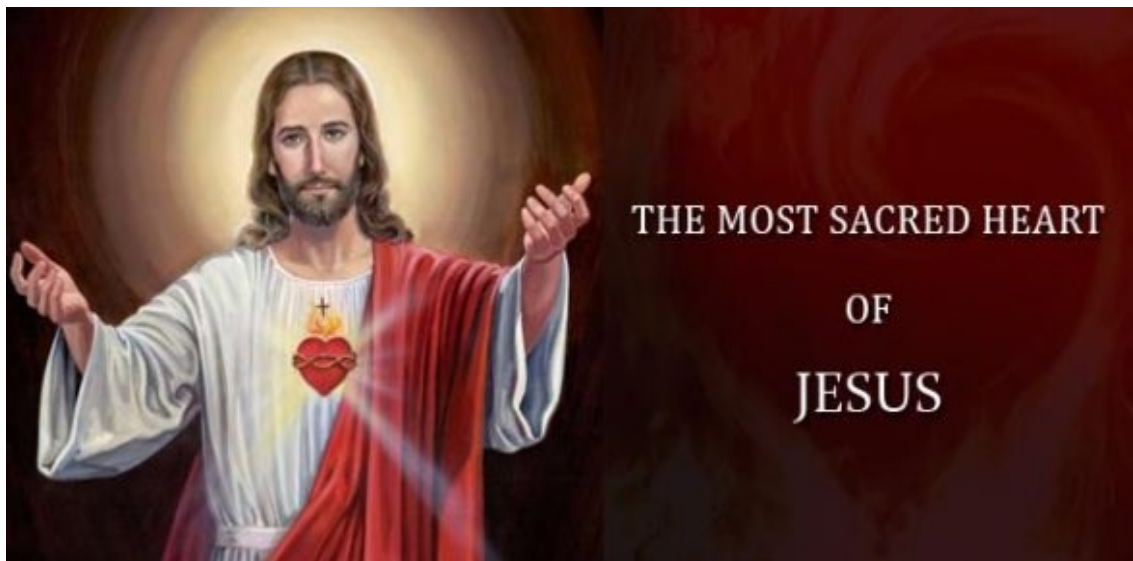

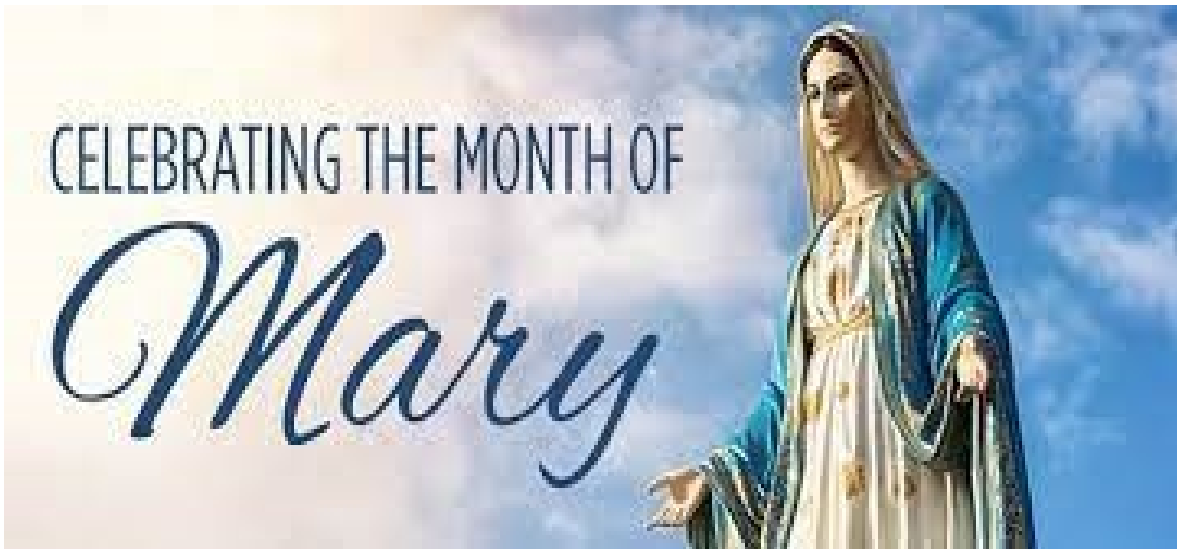
Sacred Heart Feast Day
