*11 am at Sacred Heart*

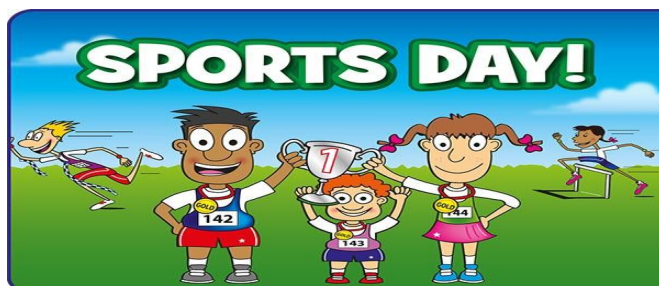
